Friends of BCH 100 Club

Terms and conditions

1. All profits from the Friends of BCH 100 Club will be used to care for sick children and their families supported by the Belarusian Children's Hospice.
2. Each share in the club will have a number and cost £5 per month. A draw will take place each month for a cash prize. The size of the prize will depend on the number of participants. If 100 shares are sold there will be a prize of £1000 in November, one prize of £500 in May and a prize of £100 in each of the other ten months of the year. Participants can buy any number of shares. The more shares you buy, the greater the chance of winning a prize. If there are more than 100 participants, the prize money will also be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of participants at the time of the draw and the prize money will increase accordingly. In the event of there being fewer than 100 participants, prizes will be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of participants at the time of the draw. It is guaranteed that the prize money each year will be at least 40% of the annual income of the club. For this purpose, the Friends of BCH 100 Club year will run from 1st June to 31st May.
3. Draws will take place on 16th of each month by at least one of the trustees of the charity in the presence of an independent witness. Winners will be sent a cheque by post and the result of each draw will be posted on the charity's website.
4. Each share costs £5 per month and can be paid for by cheque in advance every 6 months or, preferably, by quarterly or annual standing order payable on 1st of the month. Shares can be bought at any time by completing and returning an application form to The Treasurer, Friends of BCH(UK), Weller House, High Street, Amersham, HP7 0DP. If you have set up a standing order on-line please indicate this on the form. On receipt of payment, the participant will be notified of the number(s) of their share(s) which will be entered in the draw.
5. Participants can cancel their entry in the draw at any time by giving one month's written notice to the charity. Numbers can only be entered in the draw if payment has been received in time and the promoter reserves the right to reallocate any draw number where payment has not been received.
6. The Friends of BCH 100 Club is registered with Chiltern District Council and is organised by Ann Murphy, Trustee and secretary of Friends of the Belarusian Children's Hospice (UK).
